A proprietary pop-up bundle diverter lifts small stacks into the bundle stops, preventing damage from "shingling" and eliminating the need for precise adjustment of the bundle stops.

Ultra low strap tension

The LBX-Magazine is the only machine on the market that allows adjustable strap tension to as low as 2 lbs preventing indentations on book edges.


